

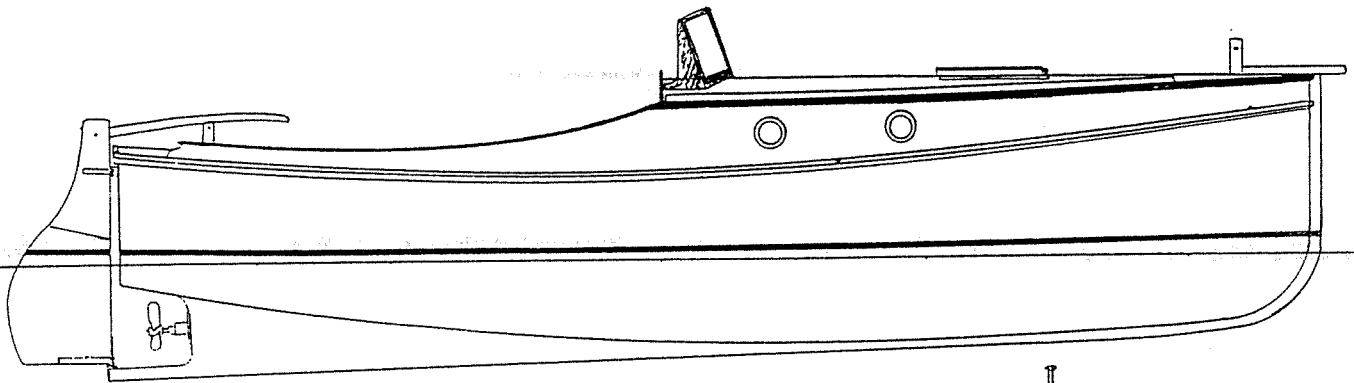
Cinema. 18 foot motor launch.

Cinema is an historic vessel still active on Sydney harbour, but not as a fishing boat as she was originally used. Now she is a little day tripper, a task she is ideal for with plenty of room for passengers and gear. The original boat features the cuddy cabin and sprite sail rig, but the plans include a raised deck with either a wheel house or windshield option.

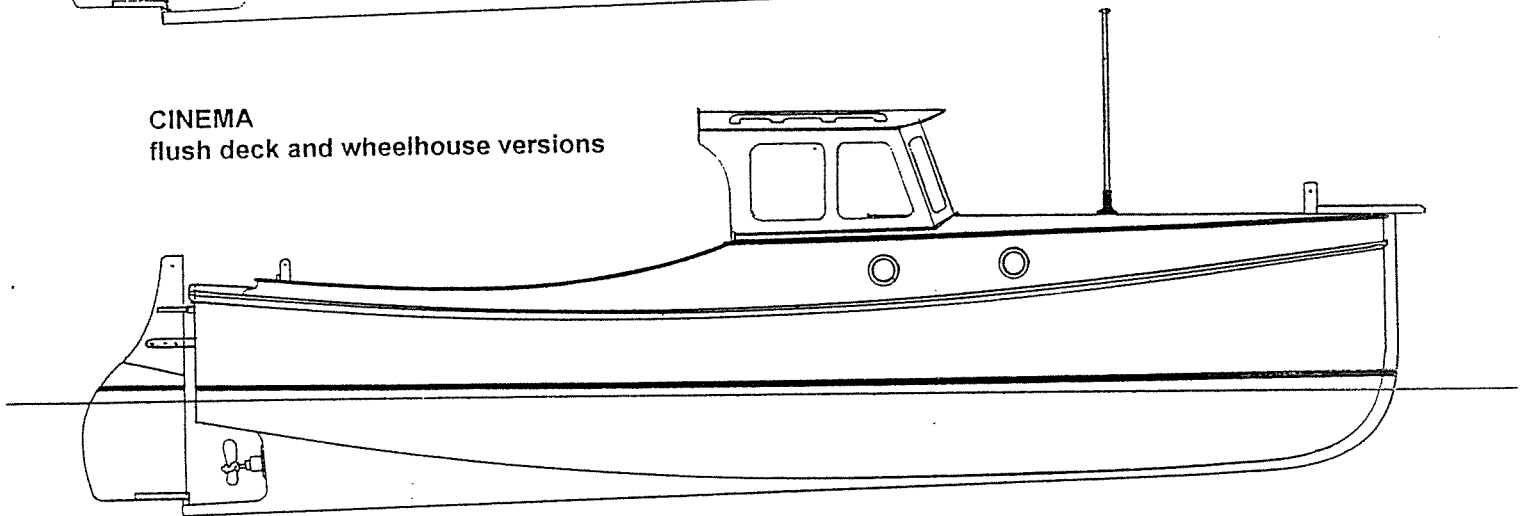
The original construction was seam batten/carvel planking. The plans drawn up are for construction in strip plank using 15mm cedar and 300 or 400 gsm reinforcement. The boat could also be built cold moulded or glued lapstrake. A 5 to 7hp engine is sufficient power.
