



"LITTLE STRIPPER"

Building a little dinghy or yacht tender is often a favoured project for first time builders. "Little Stripper" has been designed to suit strip-planking using 6mm thick western red cedar, with a 200gsm laminate on either side for reinforcement. The wide beam to length ratio, typical for a useful dinghy, has meant that the planks must twist considerably over a short distance, so tapered planks are required to make the job easier. The round bilge shape could also be cold moulded in thin ply or veneers as an alternate method.

The proportions of "Little Stripper" will allow it to carry up to 4 people, and with two rowing positions, good trim can be maintained. She is big enough to take a small outboard, and as the drawing shows, can be rigged as a sailing dinghy. A sailboard rig could also be adapted to suit, making her a fun learn-to-sail boat for youngsters.
