

## 2' MODEL SKIFF

### Model Racing Skiff

LOA	600mm
BEAM	390mm
DRAUGHT	720mm
DISPLT	10kgs

Includes full size lines, body plan and construction drawings, and 1/4 scale rig and profile drawing.

These model racing skiffs were very popular from the turn of the century up to World War II, sailed on the harbour and on lakes in Sydney. The 2' long model was very popular, and they were built as "miniatures" of full size boats in terms of their construction details.

The plans shown here are based on an existing boat called "Ozone". The lines of that boat were lifted and faired, the construction details recorded and the exiting new rig drawn to complete the drawing set. Construction involves planking the hull in thin cedar planks, however sufficient waterlines are drawn (at full size) for a hull to be built "bread and butter" style and hollowed out. The lead bulb is cast onto a stainless steel fin.
