

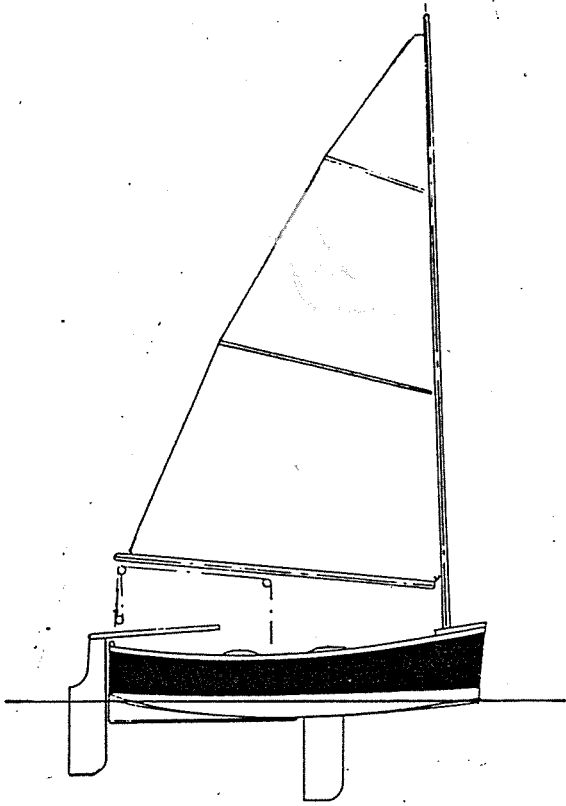
PLYWOOD DINGHIES

2m/6'6" and 2.3m 7'6" yacht tenders

LOA	2/2.3M
BEAM	1.17/1.26M

Simple plywood stitch and glue construction is often a preferred method for beginners doing their first boat building project. Construction time is quite short, techniques are straight forward and material costs are very economic. Here, the 2m boat is made from two sheets of 6mm marine plywood, fibreglass taped and filleted joints, and some additional timber for the keel, gunwales and other small items. For the 2.3m one, the materials are the same except that it uses 2½ sheets of plywood.

They both make excellent tenders. The very compact 2m hull is best with 2 people, but the larger boat can easily carry 3 adults when required. The small rig makes either boat a fun little introduction sail craft for kids.
