

6 Metre Motor Launch.

The popularity of the day tripping 5.5m Cinema has lead to this new and bigger design at 6m LOA. The greater volume allows a vee berth forward, giving us a launch capable of weekend trips or longer camping expeditions. As with Cinema, there are two versions, the cuddy cabin or raised deck and wheelhouse option, and both can be rigged with a steadying sail.

Construction has two options as well, strip plank in 15th WR Cedar and 400 gsm reinforcements, or 12mm ply glued lapstrake. Decks, cabin, bulkheads and fitout are plywood and there are the normal timber longitudinals to complete the structure. At this size she is big enough to handle the small 9 to 12hp range of diesels, making it a safe and economical craft to operate.

Plans include a lines drawing, a construction, arrangement and details drawing, a rudder and rig drawing, and a comprehensive set of offsets for hull and cabin.
