14 foot Motor Launch.

When small petrol engines were readily available and the chief form of power, many small craft existed, performing a multitude of tasks. The advent of diesels, outboard motors and planing hulls combined to replace these boats. Nowadays, there is a revival of interest in these small craft, helped by the availability of new and reconditioned low horsepower petrol engines.

This little boat has been designed to use these engines, but it is built using either contemporary strip plank or glued lapstrake construction. The former uses 9mm WR cedar and 300gsm cloth reinforcement, the latter uses 9mm ply planking. The decks are ply and there are additional timber floors, frames and other typical structure.

She is an ideal recreational fishing boat, sedate commuter vessel or daytriping launch and is easily towed behind a vehicle.
